14th Amendment, Section 1

...No state shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the <u>privileges or immunities</u> of citizens of the United States; nor shall any state <u>deprive any person of life</u>, liberty, or property, <u>without due process of law</u>; nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.

Second Amendment

A well regulated militia, being necessary to the security of a free state, the right of the people to keep and bear arms, shall not be infringed.

United States v. Miller 1939

"In the absence of any evidence tending to show that possession or use of a 'shotgun having a barrel of less than eighteen inches in length' at this time has some reasonable relationship to the preservation or efficiency of a well regulated militia, we cannot say that the Second Amendment guarantees the right to keep and bear such an instrument."

District of Columbia v. Heller 2008

"In sum, we hold that the District's ban on handgun possession in the home violates the Second Amendment, as does its prohibition against rendering any lawful firearm in the home operable for the purpose of immediate self-defense. Assuming that Heller is not disqualified from the exercise of Second Amendment rights, the District must permit him to register his handgun and must issue him a license to carry it in the home."

District of Columbia v. Heller

"* * We are aware of the problem of handgun violence in this country, and we take seriously the concerns raised by the many amici who believe that prohibition of handgun ownership is a solution. The Constitution leaves the District of Columbia a variety of tools for combating that problem, including some measures regulating handguns..."

McDonald v . City of Chicago, Illinois 2010

Held that the Second Amendment is incorporated by the Fourteenth Amendment's Due Process Cause, and thus applies to the states
